No formal registration required; however, we ask you to inform us about your intended participation and its duration (e.g. participation on Monday) – this helps us a lot with the planning; and in any case you should let us know if you want to stay overnight in the hall!

Travel to the „Georg-Gassmann-Stadion“ with your own vehicle:

If approaching from the north, leave the expressway (B 3) via the „Marburg Gisselberger Straße“ exit,

if coming from the south, take the „Marburg Süd“ exit.

Then follow the signs for „Georg-Gassmann-Stadion“ (distance after the exits approx. 1 km).

There are plenty of **free parking spaces** directly at the Georg-Gassmann-Stadion.

(Observe speed limits – speed traps!)

Arrival by Public Transportation:

Transport connections can be researched on the website of the „Rhein-Main-Verkehrsverbund (RMV)“ – <https://www.rmv.de/c/de/start/>

For example, from the bus stop „Hauptbahnhof Ost/Ortenbergsteg“, bus platform („Bussteig“) A 1 (on the other side of the tracks), take bus line 8 (direction „Dietrich-Bonhoefer-Straße“) without changing to the bus stop „Georg-Gassmann-Stadion“;

or, a little quicker, with less walking, but with one change: from the stops in front of the „Hauptbahnhof“, bus platform („Bussteig“) A 1, take line 1 (direction „Eisenacher Weg“) to „Philippshaus“, bus platform A 2, change there to line 8.

The **Großsporthalle** is located approx. 200 meters from the entrance gates of the „Georg-Gassmann-Stadion“ straight ahead, directly opposite the skater facility.

The tatami will be set up in the hall quarter on the far left, or for Monday, probably, in the „Gymnastikraum“.

Accommodation:

Overnight accomodation is possible in the hall from Friday evening onwards. Please contact us beforehand some days in advance.

There is a campsite directly in Marburg City on the banks of the Lahn - <https://www.lahnaue.de/> .

There are also about ten pitches for motorhomes set up by the town nearby.
